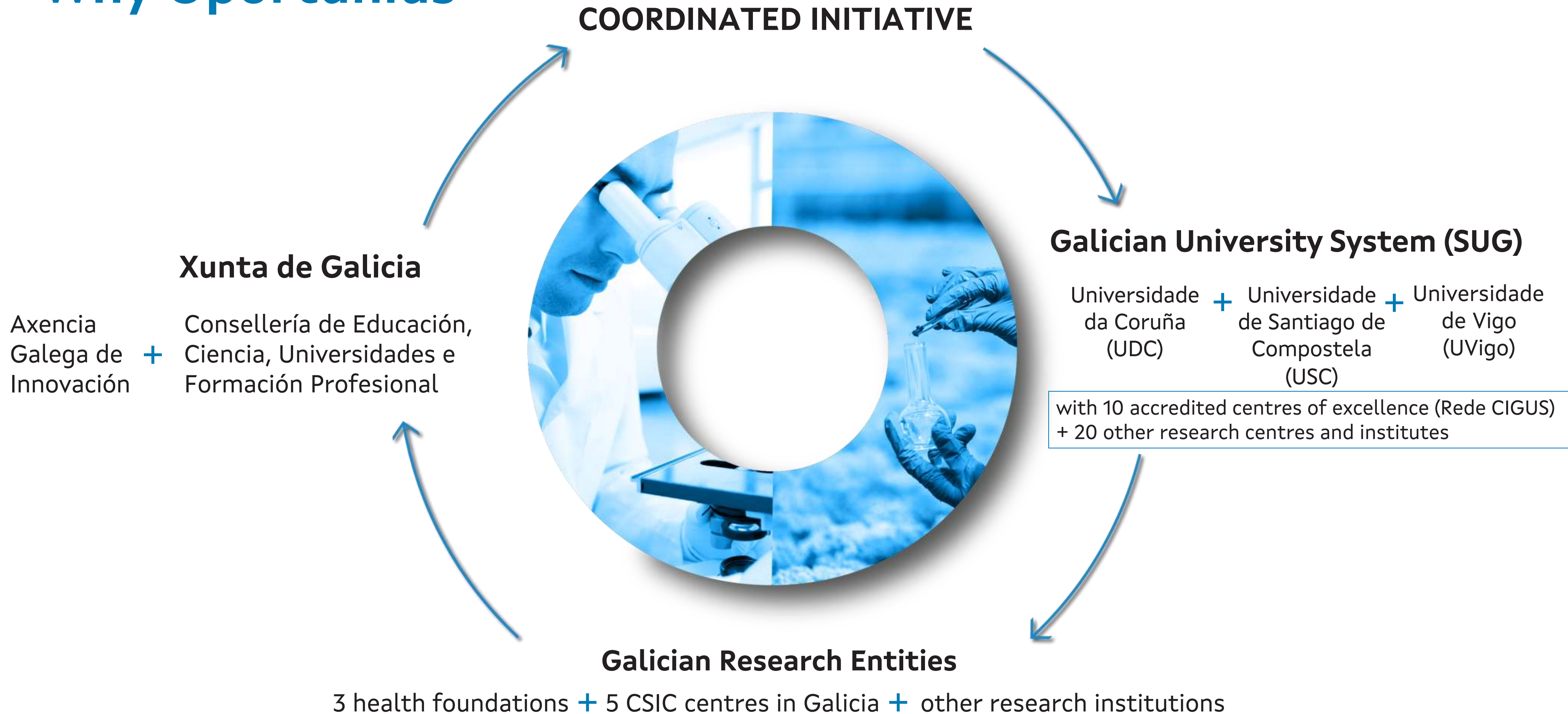

Galicia: **6th Spanish region** by number of ERCs

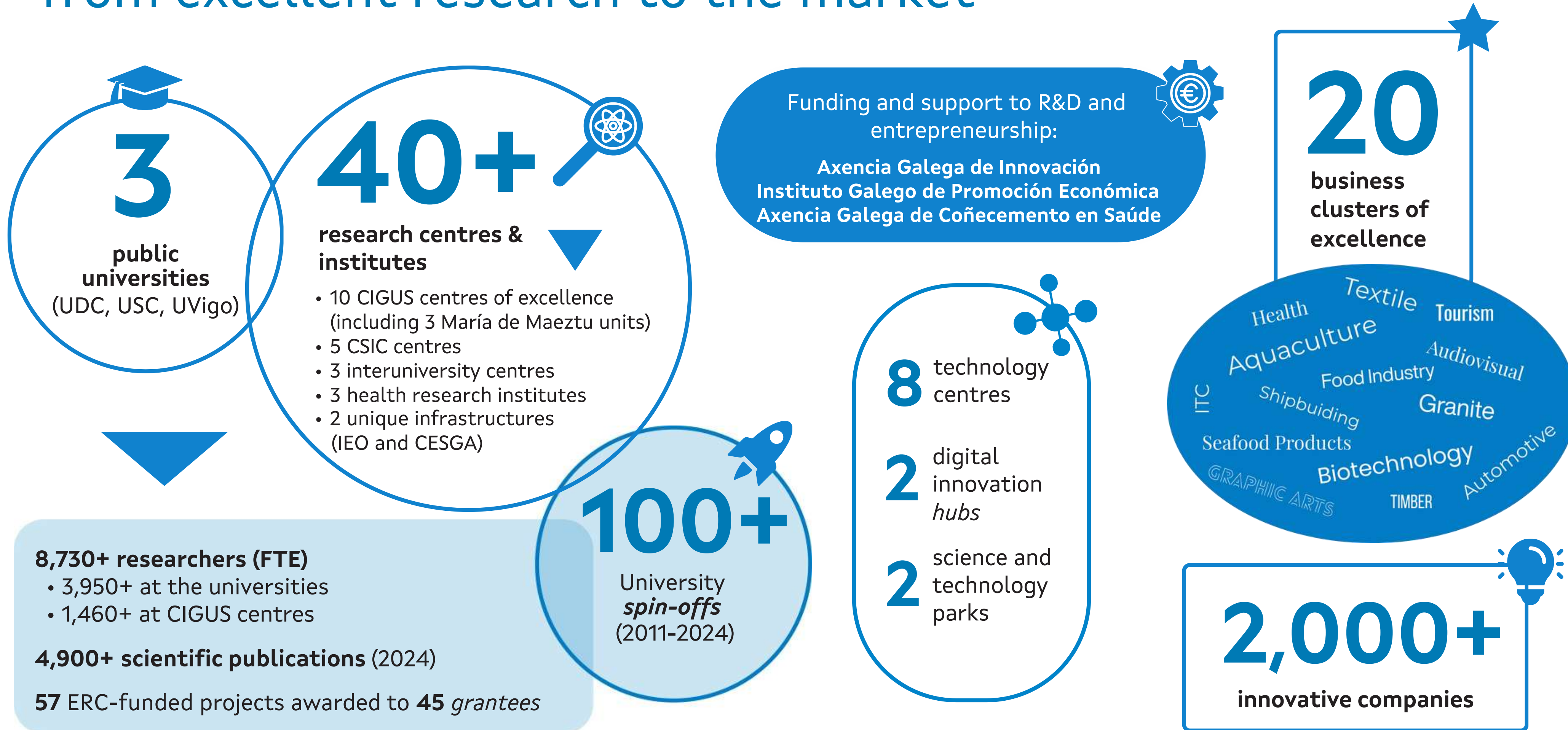

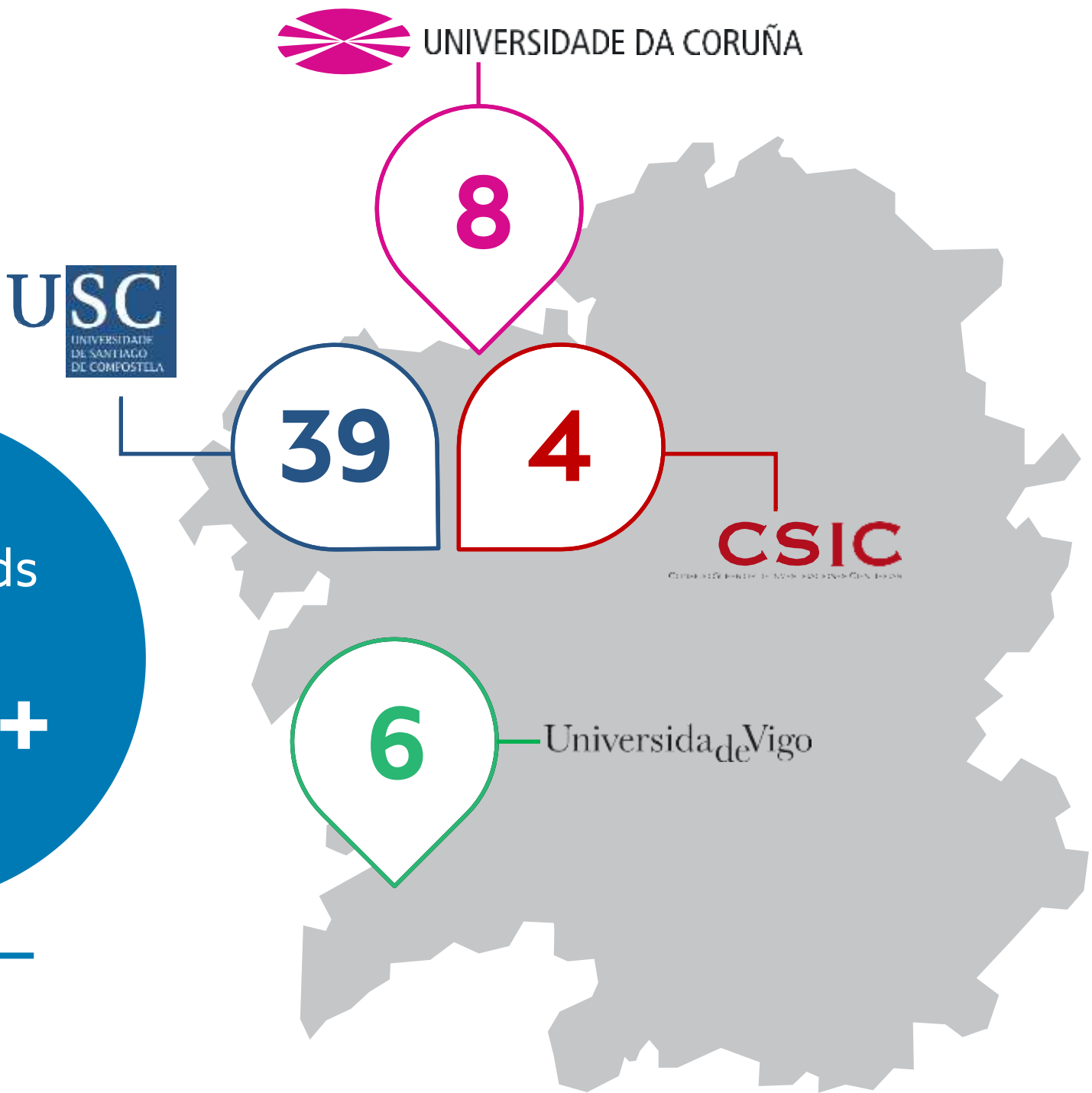
